3. Approval of July's minutes

4. Treasurers report

The bank balance is currently £3894.89. We have had no expenditure or income since last month.

5. Projects discussion

- Expenditure Policy: Future purchases to be discussed on the WhatsApp group to get approval/consensus from other members. The expenditure will then be minuted at the next meeting. Alternatively, it can be discussed at committee meeting and get general consensus from attendees. If expenditure is to be above £100, then it should be approved by the Treasurer and two other office bearers, and minuted at the next meeting.
- Examination of Accounts Still in progress. Arthur is to action this via Shelagh. OSCR Report to be completed by the end of the year.
- Work around the Trail Gillian spoke to Tracy from WLC (her remit is paths). Tracy did a walkabout during the WLC Pond Dipping event at Campbridge Pond. The paths need to be "graded" by WLC but Tracy did agree that the steps and parts of the boardwalks are quite bad. We can probably apply for funding and WLC would probably match it, so we need to fundraise. WLC will project manage any work especially as they have contacts for building materials, etc. Gillian and Alan are to pursue this and look at what grants might be available for various projects.
- Bat Boxes Central Wildlife Group. Gillian will contact the ecologist with regard to organising a bat walk/talk and survey.
