### 5. Projects discussion

- Campbridge Park was tidied up one evening with 6 volunteers. Mainly spacing on decks kept clear
  to allow water to escape and the steps weeded to improve the level of safety.
- Gillian met with Tracey Smith form the West Lothian Ranger Service. Tracey was able to respond to our request regarding a rough estimate of cost to upgrade the paths and steps in Campbridge Park. She estimated £8,200 for materials and £5,168 for labour, approx. £13,000 plus VAT.
- The above sum is significantly greater than our current reserves and fundraising will be required. Gillian plans to contact Kim Vance a previous member of MEG with whom we remain in contact and who has knowledge of fundraising for environmental projects.
- Gillian and Alan will tackle the Japanese knotweed that wasn't successfully treated last year. There
  is a very modest amount to do and a further treatment this year should eliminate all of the
  remaining knotweed. Arthur has agreed to come along and find out more re treating invasive
  species.
- We are hoping to meet Callum McLaren, Ecology and Diversity Officer from West Lothian Council, to investigate the possibility and process of erecting bat and owl boxes.
- We are looking at preparing an area of grassland to sow with wildflowers. Gillian has identified an area near Campbridge pond. In order for the seeds to grow the ground will need to be prepared. We will need to get more info re this from the ecology/ranger staff at West Lothian council.
